We would appreciate if you could contribute the following supplies to be used in your student's classroom. Any additional supplies you are able to provide will help a student and family who are unable to contribute!

Community Supplies: to be shared by all for easy distribution

1. **6 boxes of 12, #2 Ticonderoga pencils** (this seems like a lot, but the kids will use them all)
2. **1 small (4 – 6 oz.) bottle of white glue**
3. **1 box of tissues** – will be shared by all
4. **Sticky notes** – pkg. of 3 – 5 (any size)
5. **1-2 Clorox wipes-**
6. **6 Elmer's glue sticks**

Personal Supplies: please label **EACH ITEM BELOW** with students name in black Sharpie

1. **1½ inch 3-ring binder** – (NO BIGGER...they won't fit in desks) simple is best! – no extra pockets/Velcro
2. **2 Sets of 8 dividers (1 set is for the daily binder, and the other set is for the portfolio)**
3. **EXPO** dry erase markers (no yellow or other light colors)– 4-5 regular size and 3 fine point (for small whiteboards) NO ERASER needed for boards (we will provide).
4. **Set of highlighters (four different colors)**
5. **Ruler-** not bendable
6. **Calculator-** nothing fancy...just basic one please
7. **Durable pencil sharpener** (must hold shavings)
8. **Box of 12 colored pencils** (Crayola works best)
9. **Markers-** 1 pkg. fine tip **AND** 1 pkg. fat tip (Crayola works best)
10. **Scissors-** med./adult size (a must!)
11. **Pencil pouch** (zip or slide) for binder - hooks into rings of binder
12. **4 spiral notebooks-**at least 70 pages (please, no multi-section/subject spirals)
13. **Backpack** (as long as it can fit a cubby) **NO** wheels.
14. **Pencil BOX for desk supplies** (PORTER'S class only)

## Middle School Supply List

We would appreciate if you could contribute the following supplies to be used in your student's classroom. Any additional supplies you are able to provide will help a student and family who are unable to contribute!

**Community Supplies:** Supplies pooled and *available to all who need them*

One dozen pencils (#2, non-mechanical)

*Drop off community supplies with your home room teacher the first day of school.*

**Personal Supplies** (needed all year; not shared)

One 2-3 inch, 3 ring binder with tab dividers (3 tabs) and binder pouch for pencils, etc..

**Two** Composition books, college ruled, 100 Pages, 7 1/2in. x 9 3/4in.

Two 100 page spiral notebooks

**Two** boxes of colored pencils

**One** pair of scissors

**Hand pencil sharpener (not battery operated)** This needs to be replaced periodically so that the student always has a hand pencil sharpener

Scientific Calculator with fraction bar (**Texas Instruments TI-30XIIs** is THE one you really want – it is one that will last your student through high school and are what Redmond teachers use to teach from – **BUY EARLY as these tend to be impossible to find in late August/early September**)

Shelf for locker (**only 1**, optional)

1 ruler (inches and CM)

*Bring your personal supplies on the first day of school. THERE IS A LIMITED AMOUNT OF SPACE IN LOCKERS; PLEASE LEAVE PERSONAL ITEMS NOT NEEDED FOR SCHOOL AT HOME. BACKPACKS SHOULD BE SMALL AND SOFT; THEY ARE KEPT IN LOCKERS, NOT BROUGHT TO CLASS, AND PACKS ON WHEELS DO NOT FIT IN LOCKERS.*
