Incident Weather



Decisions regarding incident weather delays or school cancellations are made in the early morning (really, really early), before school. Once the decision to delay and/or close has been made, that information is communicated to parents using School Messenger (automated dialer), on the district website, **Facebook** and immediately through local media outlets.

Immunization Exclusion Day is Coming

February 21, 2018, is the Oregon Statewide School Exclusion Day for students who have not completed **ALL** of their immunizations. Please be aware, our 7th and 8th graders need a sixth DtaP to complete their immunization series, and kindergartners and 1st graders must have two doses of Hepatitis A (no less than six months apart), as well as their other required immunizations. Please check your child's records, and make the necessary arrangements to bring their immunizations up to date through a doctor's office, the School Based Health Clinics (at M.A. Lynch Elementary School-541-923-5800, and Redmond High School-541-923-8920), or the Deschutes County Health Department.. Thank you for partnering with us in keeping our student's healthy, and in achieving our goal of zero immunization exclusions!
